

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

The admission procedure has been simplified to facilitate the applicants. The admission applications must be submitted on PRESCRIBED forms attached with the college prospectus before the last date of submission of applications. The prescribed admission forms are printed separately. Students should file admission form filling the relevant program.

Fill in the relevant form and submit it in the college office under a receipt. Attach attested copies of your certificates and photographs with the application form.

- 2. Provisional Certificate of Result Card of Intermediate Examination for BS admission.
- Result Card ADC for BS Commerce 5th semester.
- 4. Certificate of Good Moral Character from the Head of the Institute attended last time.
- 5. Computerized National Identity Card of the candidate and his/her Father/Guardian.
- 6. Three recent passport-size photographs with name and father's name on the back.
- 7. Migration Certificate (in case the applicant has passed the Intermediate Examination from a Board other than B.I.S.E. Lahore and Punjab Board of Technical Education)
- 8. "B" Form for Intermediate Admission.

COLLEGE IDENTITY CARD

Each student will have to display his / her college identity card on the front pocket during his / her presence in college. In case of loss of an identity card, a duplicate one will be issued on payment of Rs. 50/= The second duplicate card could be issued on submission of an Affidavit on stamp – paper worth Rs.20/=(duly attested) along with payment of Rs. 100/= to the college office.

Outgoing students will have to return their identity cards to the college office otherwise their library security will be confiscated as per Govt. instructions.

The students must keep their college cards worn during the academic hours so that the college security system may be streamlined and be made better.

The College Security Teams/Proctorial Board shall check the cards of the students to ensure a conducive and protected college academic atmosphere for the students in the respective colleges.

- (e) False Statement / Fake documents.

COLLEGE MAGAZINE

The college shall get the college magazine published during every academic session as per the directions of the Higher Education Department. The College Editorial Board shall ensure the inclusion of only those articles in the magazines those are not controversial. The material included in each article or other sections may become a source of healthy information, broadening of the vision, development of the character and enjoyment of the students of the colleges.

PTM (Parents Teacher Meeting)

Regular PTMs at our college foster collaboration between parents and teachers, ensuring student's progress is effectively monitored.

PROCTORS

Our college has a dedicated proctorial system to maintain discipline and ensure a positive learning environment. Proctors assist in enforcing rules, addressing student concerns, and promoting a culture of responsibility. This system helps in creating a well-organized and respectful campus atmosphere.

STUDENTS' LEAVE RULES

The following students leave rules shall be observed in all the Public Sector colleges of the Province:-

- 1. The students, seeking leave, must send in the leave application, duly signed by the parents, to the Principal of the College.
- 2. In case of illness, leave for more than 4-days shall only be allowed if the ailing student submits the Medical Certificate duly issued by the MS or the authorized Medical Attendants of Government Hospitals.
- 3. Leave for Two days may be got sanctioned by the English Teachers/ Tutors and leave for more than two days may be got sanctioned by the Principals concerned.
- 4. A student who shall remain absent from the college for 15 days continuously his/ her name shall be struck off. However, readmission will be considered on the request of the parents/guardian. This facility shall only be available once in the academic session.
- 5. The students who shall not join the college after getting admitted to First Year/Part I class and Second Year /Part II class after the start of the Academic Session shall not be eligible for sending of their admission by the college to the Board.

ATTENDANCE

A candidate with less than 75% of attendance in lectures shall not be allowed to take the final examination in a course.

STUDENT FINE

The following fines shall be allowed to be imposed on the students by the college authorities and the same shall be deposited into the college account concerned through the Fine slip in the Bank Concerned. The following are the different Rates of the Fine:-

RULES & REGULATIONS OF DISCIPLINE

Pursuit of education requires perfect discipline, good behavior, sensible attitude, sober habits and civilized manners. Irresponsibility and rowdyism neutralize and nullify all constructive endeavors. Students are, therefore expected and advised to observe all college rules and regulations that may be introduced from time to time. The College Disciplinary Committee offers necessary information and guidance to students, so as to maintain discipline on the College Campus.

However, the following rules and regulations must be strictly and faithfully observed by the students:

- Every student shall follow the following code of honour that is enunciated as the basic principle of conduct prescribed by the University of The Punjab:
 - (a) Respect for order, morality, personal honour and rights of others.
 - (b) Honesty and integrity in dealings with fellow students, teachers and others both on and off the College Campus.
 - (c) Protection of the college property and of the fellow students.
 - (d) Showing due respect to the elders, teachers and outside visitors.
 - (e) Courteous and helpful behavior towards all those with whom they come in contact.
 - (f) Pledge to work hard and complete the course of study in the shortest possible period without wasting time or causing disturbance to others.
- Every student is required to attend the classes regularly and punctually as per college time table.
- No student is allowed to leave the lecture room during lecture without permission of the teacher.
- Immediately after assembly of the classes the rolls may be called and the absence of the student is noted. A student coming late into the class. room will be marked absent unless his / her excuse is accepted by the teacher.
- Students are not permitted to remain in the class room except during the prescribed hours of lectures.
- Any grievances that the student may have with regard to the college life should be brought to the notice of their tutors who will make enquiry and
 forward / refer the case to the Principal, if necessary.
- Students are not allowed to address any higher authority directly. Any communication to any higher authority must be submitted to the Principal who will
 forward it, if necessary or desirable.
- Representation on any subject by the students to the Principal must be made separately. Joint applications etc are strictly prohibited.
- Students are allowed direct access to the Principal. The Principal and the tutors will consider any difficulties / hardships / grievances of the students sympathetically. Efforts will be made to solve their genuine problems.
- Smoking on the college premises is strictly prohibited. Severe action will be taken against the defaulters.
- Students who indulge in any act likely to disturb peace in the classroom or peaceful pursuit of education shall be dealt with severely by the class teacher who will take necessary corrective measures including imposition of fine.
- The fine imposed on the students by the teachers for misbehavior etc. shall not be waived off as a matter of routine.
- Any student who will be involved in sale / supply of, and /or who is addicted to drugs/narcotics/such as heroine shall be expelled from the college.
- Non payment of the college dues etc. within the specified period will render a student liable to be struck off the college rolls. The name of the student will
 also be struck off from class/classes for the continuous absence for the fortnight without permission.

- (xv) Every subject is compulsory. Students must attend at least 75% of the lectures delivered in every subject so as to qualify themselves to take the University Examination.
- (xvi) In case a student commits any offence on and /or off the college campus, and persistently indulges in objectionable activities, he will render himself liable to action as under in accordance with the nature and gravity of the offence etc. The offender/delinquent may be directed to tender a written apology for the objectionable act or and to furnish an undertaking for good behaviour in future. A special fine may be imposed upon him. Any financial assistance, scholarship, fee concession etc. allowed to him may be suspended/cancelled or withdrawn. He may by suspend from the classes. He may be directed to withdraw his name from the college rolls. If he fails to withdraw his name immediately after being directed/called upon to do so, it may be struck off the college rolls without any further notice to him. He may be expelled from the college.
- (xvii) The Supreme Court of Pakistan has banned the formation of student bodies/organizations in the educational institutions. The Students are required to abstain from all such activities. They should not indulge in any political activities otherwise such students will be expelled from the college.
- (xviii) The students are not allowed to carry arms in the College Campus.
- (xix) The principal may allow a student to pay the dues by installments on humanitarian grounds as a special case.
- (xx) The students are not allowed to carry mobile phones in the classes. Otherwise their mobiles will be held by the college authorities and will not be returned.

COLLEGE LIBRARY

It is housed at first floor consisting of about 30,000 books. It is exclusively open for Intermediate and BS students. Books relevant to Intermediate and BS Syllabus are available – besides dailies and periodicals. The Library has reference books and publications in the field of Accounting, Business Communication, English Language, Business Mathematics and Statistics, Business Taxation, Computer Science, Macro and Micro Economics, Financial Management, Management Sciences, Insurance, Marketing, Mercantile and Labour Laws, Quantitative Techniques for Business and Banking, Allied subjects and religion. An addition to books is made every year to meet the curricula and research needs of students and faculty.

LIBRARY RULES:

- (1) The Library is open for the use of the students and teaching staff of the college only. No book shall be issued to the non member except with the sanction of the principal.
- (2) The Library card and books are strictly non transferable. Students are not allowed to draw books for others on their own cards. Sub lending of books drawn from the Library to any other person is prohibited.
- (3) The Library card must be brought to the Library and shall have to be presented at the counter at the time of drawing or returning books. If a card is lost, a new one will be issued after 3 days on payment of Rs. 25/= with the latest photograph. The borrower is in all cases responsible for books drawn on his card. The responsibility continues if the card is lost or used by any other person.
- (4) Students of ADC may have in their possession not more than one book at a time.
- (5) Books drawn by borrowers shall be returned not later than the period prescribed on the date slip, pasted at the end of the each volume.
- (6) Books of reference, Encyclopedia, Dictionaries and Current Periodicals are not lent out.
- (7) When more than one student want a book, then it is given in turn. Preference is given to those who have not got before.
- (8) A minimum fine of Re.10/= per book for each day will be imposed in case books are kept over due date.

- (9) Books should not be mutilated, marked or pages torn out. They must be handled carefully and with clean hands. When borrowing books, students are requested to bring to the notice of the Librarian marks made or any other damage done to the books, otherwise the student who draws the books in the last will be held responsible for the damage.
- (10) Book(s) lost, damaged or mutilated in anyway by a student shall have to be replaced or paid. The cost of such books shall be doubled the prevailing cost plus additional 25% departmental charges.

Computer Lab: The College has well equipped computer lab to teach IT subjects to intermediate and BS students.

HOUSE TEST & SEND - UP EXAMINATION

- Students of Intermediate have to take class tests on monthly basis. Absentees are imposed special fine. Performance report of every student is sent to his / her parents regularly.
- Students of all AD and BS Programs are bound to appear in Mid-term examination. Absentees / failures are imposed special fine and their examination
 forms may not be sent to the University
- The College ensures the conduct of transparent and fair examinations in the colleges. The Academic Calendar of the Department is adhered to in letter
 and spirit in connection with the conduct of the examinations. The College Authorities shall ensure the following
- Attendance of the students in the college Monthly tests is compulsory.
- The Teachers must keep the attendance record of the students in a well-prepared form right from the beginning of the academic session till its completion.
- The record of the Monthly tests as per the Academic Calendar must be entered into the register by the teacher concerned.
- The Attendance Registers of the students must be checked either by the Vice Principal or the Principal on monthly basis and duly sign them.
- It is compulsory for all the students to appear in all college tests including class tests, mid-term tests, December Tests & Pre Board / University Tests and pass the same.
- A fine of Rs. 200 per paper for absence in December, Mid-term & Pre Board / University tests shall be charged from the students and deposited into the Bank into the relevant fine fund through college fine slip.
- Students not participating in the college examinations on medical grounds must produce a Medical Certificate duly issued by the MS or Authorized Medical Attendant of a Government Hospital otherwise the student shall be declared fail. Furthermore, after getting well, it will be compulsory to appear in the examination so missed due to illness.
- The cases of the students using unfair means during any examination of the college shall be presented before the College Council and the decision of the College Council shall be final and the same cannot be challenged in any court or legal forum.
